care – generosity – serve – **mission**

The **gospel** story of Jesus Christ
is a story about Jesus as **Messiah**,
Jesus as **Lord**, Jesus as **Savior**, and Jesus as **Son**.

Talking through the message during the week helps turn what God is saying to you into action steps. We are *kaleo*, or **called by** Christ to be on mission.

Read **Matthew 28:18-20**

- Who has God put around you that doesn't know Christ?
- What are some specific ways you can reach out and disciple?
- Why do we shy away for discipling others?

Read **Ecclesiastes 4:9-10**

- One way we become more like Christ is by being part of a community of Christ followers. Describe a time when a community of Christ followers helped you grow in your faith.
- What are some of the challenges that sometimes make it difficult for people to experience this kind of community?
- How will you personally answer Christ's call to go make disciples? How will you answer this call as a group?

Read **Romans 12:1-2**

- Is this a good description of being a follower of Jesus?
- Because the word "disciple" is not used a lot today, Mike suggested words like "learner" or "apprentice". Are these good words? Why/why not? What are some other words that describe this ongoing walk of living out faith?
- What do you need, to be or to become a disciple of Jesus?

Next Steps

- Do you think God is calling you to go and become "*fishers of men/women*"?
- What are some specific things you can do this week to disciple someone?
- Pray with your group and during your personal prayer time this week for God to give you a desire to make disciples of others.
- Pray for those God has put around you that do not know Christ and that He will give you opportunities to reach out to them.

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
